Torino Style Hot Chocolate.

There are so many recipes that have not passed down that we could likely write another cook book. With the seasons changing it is time to release the secret recipe for Torino style hot chocolate.

Not all of us have an espresso machine so I am going to present this with a few variations. If you do not have an espresso machine, then get out your thermos bottle and pre-heat it with hot water from your tap. You will be using it as a shaker just as you would with cold drinks – shaken not stirred.

Please make sure to try this recipe a few times **without** adding the usual suspects that wreck what you think needs to go into hot chocolate – whipping cream, marshmallows or spices.

- 1. You will need an espresso. It can be from a machine, instant espresso or even one from those little bottles. The bottles are actually great if you are camping or on a picnic.
- A bar of dark chocolate 70% cocoa or more will do the trick as we are trying to reduce the amount of processed sugar. If you have a bar that is 3.5 oz (100 grams) then use about 20% of the bar. Use a cheese grater to shred two squares of the bar.
- 3. A tablespoon of marscaopne cheese. This is in the little tubs at your cheese counters.
- 4. A teaspoon of coconut palm sugar widely available in grocery or specialty food stores and much better for you.

Heat the espresso to just about a boil in a small pan. Next gently add the shredded dark chocolate. Then, add the coconut palm sugar. Last the marscaopne cheese in little bits so it melts evenly.

When the mixture comes up to nearly a soft boil either run it through the steamer on your espresso machine or, transfer it to your pre-heated thermos. Give the thermos a dozen good shakes. Pour into little coffee cups and enjoy. The nice part is with a thermos you can take your hot chocolate on a walk or hike and enjoy it later.
