Italian Murder Mystery Series

For those of you that love a good murder mystery with an Italian flare, I have found a series by author Ruth Downie that may just satisfy your appetites. While many of us know of the movies and books that put an evil spin on being an immigrant, the Gaius Ruso Mysteries paint a classic picture of Italian immigration most folks tend to ignore. The main character - Gaius Ruso - is a doctor and medical investigator who himself is caught up in the problems of solving intricate murders. This includes himself being accused and threatened as a target of the efforts of the murderers to hide their crimes.

Readers may find it interesting that he lives in the time of Emperor Hadrian. The Italians of the day – Romans – have immigrated to the Island and taken over as much of Britannia as they possibly can. The Romans' life styles, low social opinion of their neighbors and the very economic reasons for being there – clash with the locals in the worst ways.

The year is A.D. 122. Emperor Hadrian is having a wall built clear across the island to protect the neighborhood they have conquered; separating them from the "barbarians." Remember: anyone can be a Roman citizen – like it or not. Just take away electricity and everything associated with it – computers, telephones, cameras, etc. and the setting still is ripe – for intrigue, mystery and the worst of human emotions being expressed via murder on other humans. 
Nothing has changed, just the time line.

The series comes in printed books as well as audio and e-print. If you ever wondered why history seems to repeat itself, you will find some of the answers in reading these stories.




