(Dennis Caldirola sent this notice in an email on November 7th.) Following the loss in September of beloved Honorary Life Member Fr. Carmine Sacco, according to the Seattle Times yesterday, we have lost another in Fr. Gary Morelli who died on October 28th at age 75. Fr. Gary was the pastor at St. Francis Assisi Parish in Oak Harbor, St. Edward Parish, St. John Bosco Parish in Lakewood, and most recently, at Holy Family Parish in Kirkland. Fr. Gary also shared a historical link to the Italian Club of Seattle when the organization was at its zenith. His father was member Ermon "Ermie" Morelli who contracted kidney disease in the 1960's and was one of the first people in the world to undergo modern dialysis - which was invented in Seattle. To pay for his very expensive treatment, the Italian Club started an annual series of fundraising banquets to benefit the NW Kidney Foundation. These banquets came to be known as the Ermie Morelli Dinners and over the years raised tens of thousands of dollars for kidney research. As a young priest, Fr. Gary always attended and gave the invocation, and over the years, he never forgot the Italian Club and what we did in his father's memory. His funeral Mass is scheduled for 10 AM, Wed, Nov 9th at Holy Family Catholic Church in Kirkland.

Poli opposti (Opposites Attract)

A film review by Joel Patience

It has been a long time since I recommended a film. We see some films as part of our Tuesday date nights but we are selective; eliminating previews with lots of violence, those that show off limitless volume of their speakers and reviews with ties to production companies. Complements go to SIFF and its trust in Claudio Mazzola - who focuses on selecting current Italian films and for taking time to find this film that entertains us with a bit of what one might call "civilized passion". November 7 we thoroughly enjoyed the SIFF (Seattle International Film Festival) Italian release of Poli opposti (Opposites Attract). It was the first film by Director Max Croci who was also in attendance to answer questions for the audience. Mr. Croci, together with a group of talented writers and actors has produced a film that one should feel comfortable to take their sweet heart and family to. One might call the film Poli opposti = delizioso – a dessert for the heart.

Poli opposti is built on fragments of historical film smiles proven to charm audiences that find the difficulty in forming of love relations alluring. That would be most of us. A divorce attorney Claudia (Sarah Felberbaum) lives for the chance to extract a pound or more of flesh from the spouses of her mostly female clients. Sefephano (Luca Argentero) is a couples therapist that does his best to bring couples back together. They have offices just across the corridor but, are philosophically and emotionally on other planets. They share some of the same friends at arms length and try not to admit they secretly admired one another in childhood. Their relationship develops drama from the complexity of modern living - while being attracted by some of the most personal and touching emotions humans can ever wish to express to another. The body language of audience members conveyed outright encouragement for the film's couple trying to fall in love; only to have their efforts interrupted by the other factors in their lives; temptation, hesitation, suspicion of their own hearts and the influence of others.

This movie is in Italian with English subtitles and available currently in dvd for Italian machines. It will also be available via some other technology for you to enjoy. The chance to purchase a dozen copies as that perfect holiday gifts is delayed but, only until it becomes available for U.S. dvd players. Let's keep this between us so as to not spoil the surprise for my friends and family. I would encourage readers to see this film as it will add a sense of romance to your lives and encourage your travels – at least across the corridor if not to Italy.
